**Don't miss these key locations:**

### Subject Stands (21, 37, 38)

Explore subject-specific spaces, where you can see where you'll be studying. Staff at these stands are available to answer any course-related questions.

### Student Services and Application Support (3, 6)

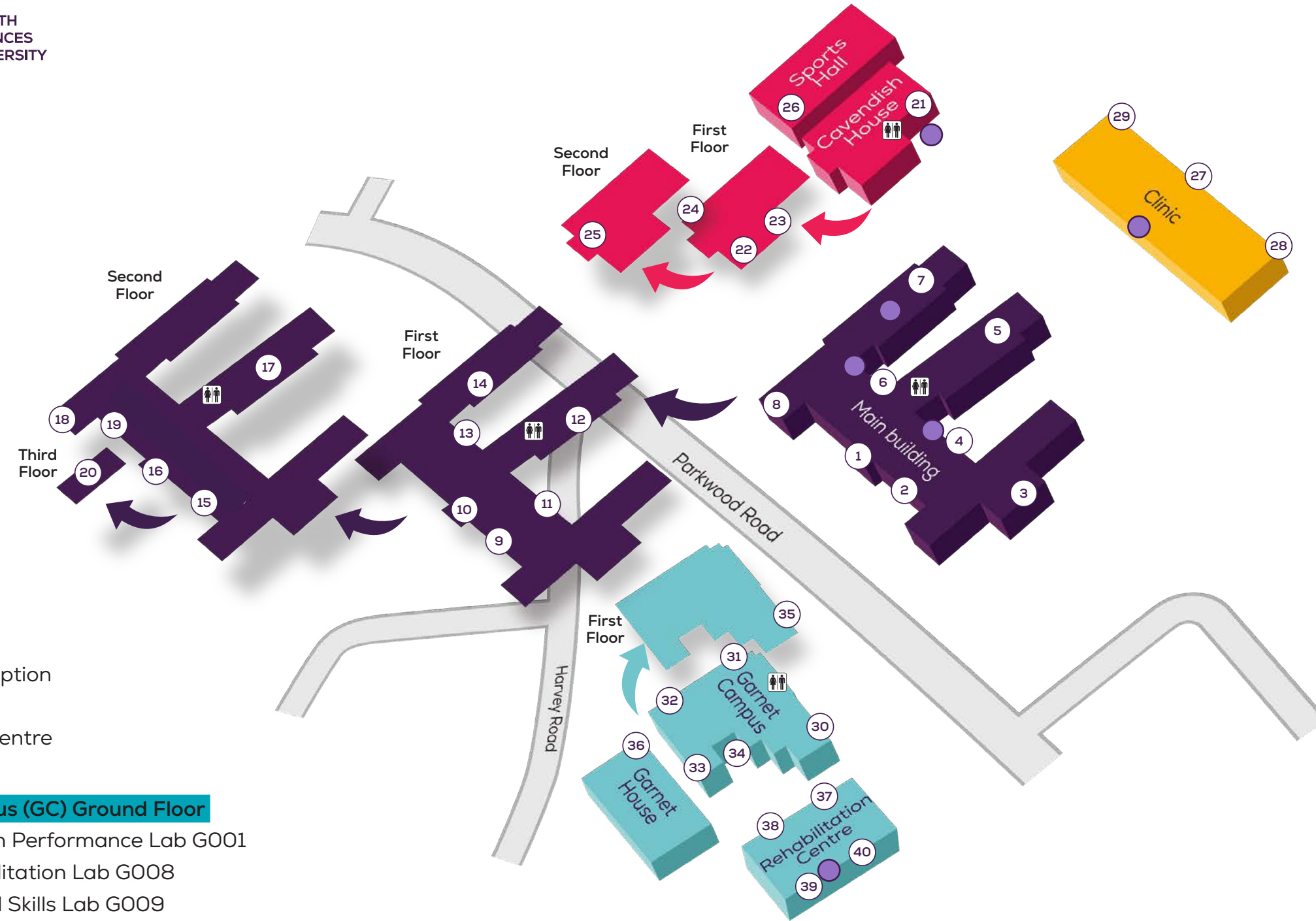
